Advisory services

What are advisory services?

Services aimed at providing information regarding sexual violence (among children and adolescents under 18) and problematic sexual behaviours (among children under 12), as well as assisting practitioners in identifying the most appropriate interventions to implement.

-  **Who is this service for?** Practitioners working in the health and social services network, community organizations, police services, the education and early childhood sectors, as well as professionals in private practice.
-  **How to book an appointment?** Professionals wishing to schedule an advisory service must contact Marie-Vincent's reception, where available time slots will be offered. However, this is not an emergency service and callback times may vary between 48 and 72 business hours.
-  **Appointment details:** Advisory services are provided by a psychosocial clinician. They generally require one or two phone calls, each lasting about 30 minutes, and are offered free of charge.

* Please note : This service does not cover psychotherapeutic interventions.

Professional Consultation Service

What is professional consultation?

A service designed to provide occasional, targeted support for the development or enhancement of knowledge concerning sexual violence (among children and adolescents under 18) and problematic sexual behaviours (among children under 12), as well as skills related to assessment and intervention, including psychotherapy, within this field.

-  **Who is this service for?** Practitioners from the health and social services network, community organizations, police services, the education and early childhood sectors, as well as professionals in private practice who have previously received advisory services and whose current needs extend beyond informational or support objectives or relate specifically to the field of psychotherapy.
-  **How to book an appointment?** Following an advisory appointment, the psychosocial intervention team may recommend this service based on their assessment. If applicable, your request will, with your authorization, be forwarded to the Clinical Services Coordination team, who will arrange an appointment as soon as possible depending on the clinical team's availability.
-  **Appointment details:** Professional consultations are conducted by a psychotherapist from the team who specializes in sexual violence and problematic sexual behaviours, and who possesses the necessary qualifications to provide formal consultations. The consultation generally consists of one or two sessions, each lasting 45 to 60 minutes, and is provided free of charge.

If the identified needs exceed the scope of this service or the allotted number of sessions, the consulting professional will be advised to seek external supervision.

Good to know!

In accordance with the requirements of the Ordre des psychologues du Québec, the professional receiving this service **must complete a formal consultation consent form**. This service also differs from clinical supervision, as it is not provided within a professional monitoring or oversight context.
